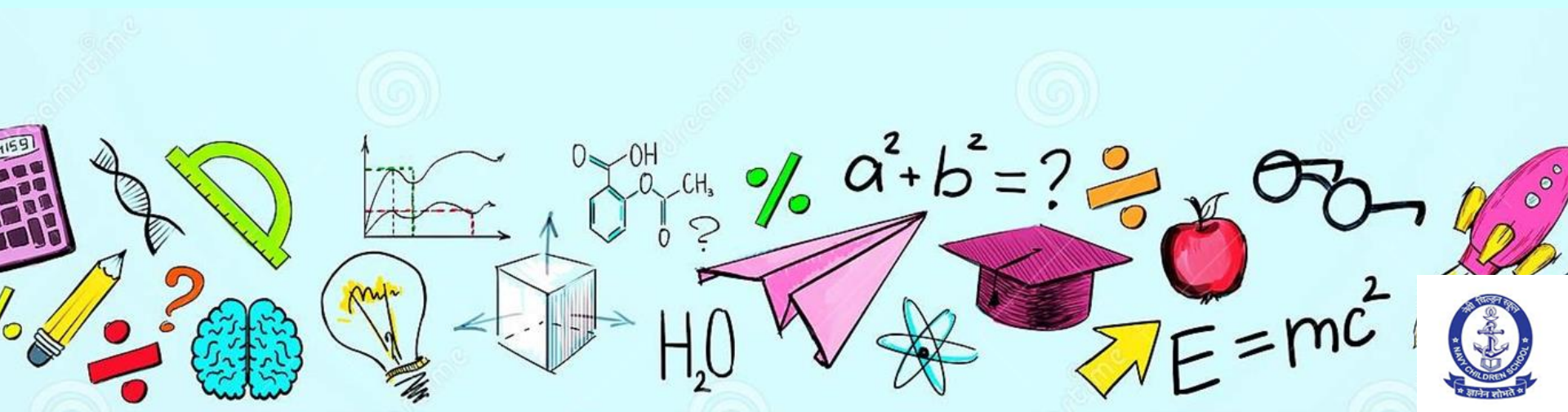

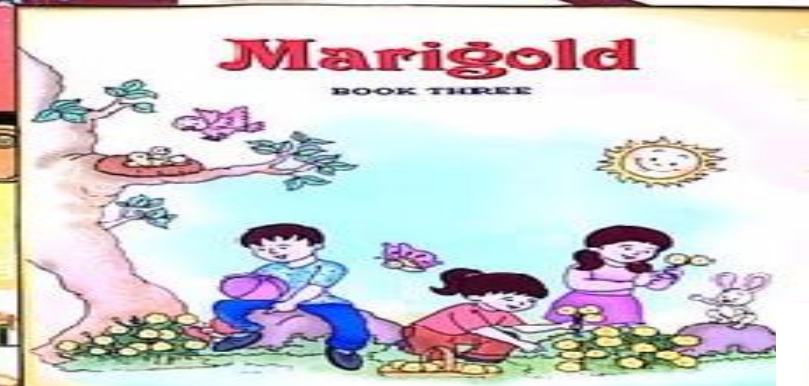
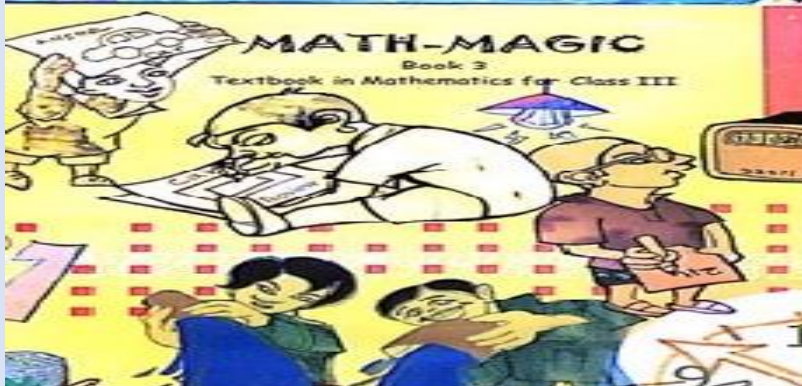

Our school is conducting various competitions and activities in relation to this.



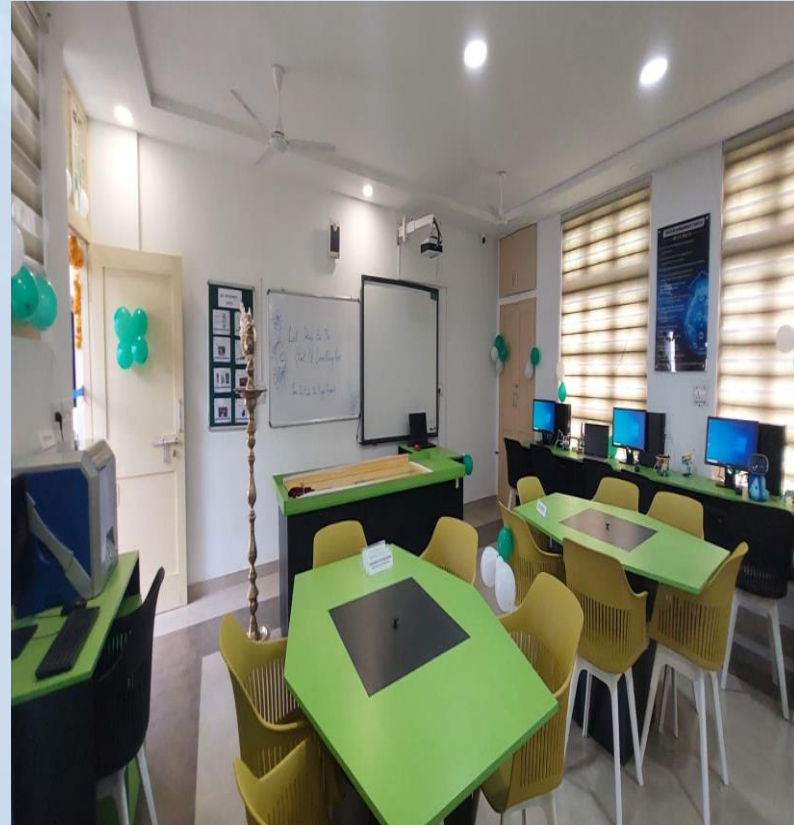

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS



1. STAY UPDATED!!!

- Regularly visit our school website to keep yourself updated

- Kindly ensure regularity in payment of fees.



2. ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

- 75% attendance is mandatory.
- In case a student needs leave prior intimation in prescribed format (given in almanac) to be submitted to class teacher.
- Kindly plan outstation trip during school holidays to avoid absenteeism.
- Please note no pupil to be sent to school if he or she is suffering from contagious disease.



3. PARENTS CONTRIBUTION TO REDUCE SCHOOL BAG WEIGHT

- Choose the right backpack for kids. Let comfort be of prime importance. Avoid trolley backpacks.
- Take only the books that are required for a particular day.
- Use small water bottles. Safe drinking water is available at school.

- Parents who come to drop and pick up your ward can wait near the respective school gate. Walking students to their classroom everyday is not entertained.

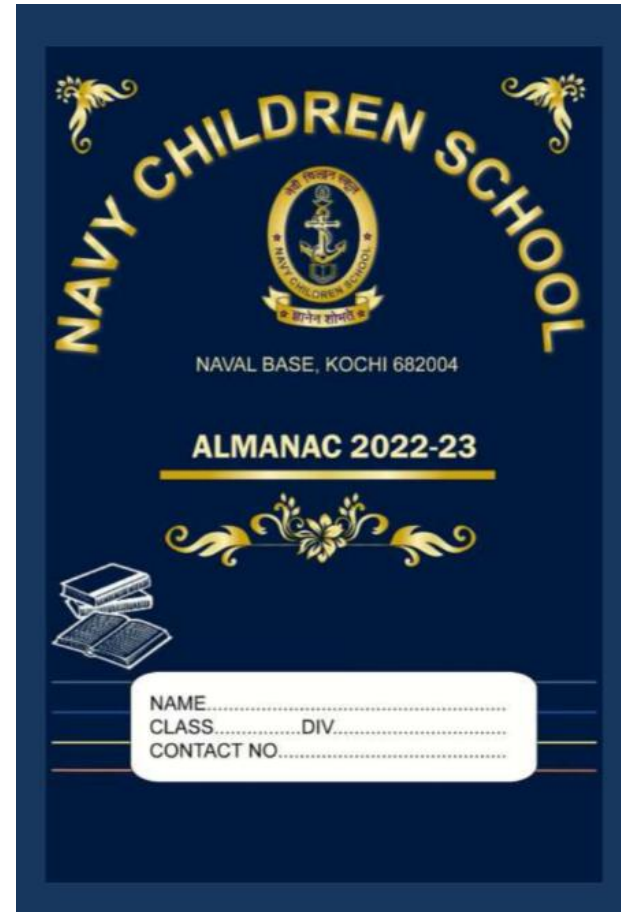
